- Meeting was called to order by President Brad Schroeder. John Schortgen, Tim Nadler, Nichol Hohenbrink, and Sam Walther were also in attendance.
- Board members approved minutes from previous meetings and financial statements as presented.
- Board accepted band instruments as donated by the Leipsic United Methodist Church.
- Under new business, the Board approved three advances and one advance back. Also approved were the invoices submitted for payment
- Board members authorized the treasurer to let bids for a new 84-passenger transit school bus.
- Board accepted the resignation of Alice Dewar as superintendent of Leipsic Local School District effective July 31, 2012.

- Board voted for Brad Schroeder to serve as Board President pro-tem from January 1, 2012 through January 10, 2012.
