

## ***Leipsic Board of Education Highlights for February 23, 2009***

***The Leipsic Board of Education met for a special February 23 meeting at 7:00 p.m. in the high school library. All five Board members were in attendance.***

***The Board approved the Memorandum of Understanding for Dual Credit-Post Secondary Enrollment Option Instruction between James A. Rhodes State College and Leipsic High School.***

***A Board passed the Resolution for the Program of Requirements Design Phase Submission for the Ohio School Facilities Commission (OSFC) Classroom Facilities Assistance Program (CFAP) Construction Project and Acknowledging OSFC Comments on the Gymnasium Space.***

***Board President Brad Schroeder, Treasurer David Miller, and Superintendent Abby Dewar have scheduled a meeting with Mike Shoemaker, executive director of OSFC, on March 4<sup>th</sup> to discuss project concerns.***

***Kraig Beilharz, from Beilharz Architects, presented heating options for the 1963 addition of the existing building. It is the intention of the Board to keep the '63 addition, which includes the varsity gym, as a stand-alone facility. Any upgrades to that addition will be funded locally. In addition, Board members discussed an immediate concern regarding the roof for that addition. Beilharz was asked to prepare documents for roof replacement as soon as possible.***

***During Planning and Discussion, Mrs. Dewar presented written copies of the 2009 State of Schools. She asked Board members to take time to read the report and noted that the opportunity for discussion will be available at the next regular Board meeting. Board members congratulated Devin Bramel and the Leipsic High School Pep Band on the outstanding performances throughout the basketball season.***
