

***Leipsic Board of Education Special Meeting Highlights
Tuesday, June 29, 2010
Administrative Conference Room***

The Leipsic Board of Education held a special meeting on Tuesday, June 29 at 6:30 p.m. in the administrative conference room. Board member Tim Nadler was not in attendance.

The following fiscal items were approved with a vote of 4-0:

- Administrative non-exempt employees are receiving no salary increases for the 2010-2011 school year. This mirrors the 0% increase for union employees.
- Disposal of inventory, textbooks and records as presented.
- Contract for services with the NOACSC for 2010-2011 school year as presented.
- The renewal proposal for property and liability insurance with SORSA through Fawcett, Lammon, Recker, and Associates as presented at a cost of \$35,802.00.
- Membership in the CompManagement workers' compensation group rating program for 2011 at a cost of \$1,805.00.
- Transfers, advances, and advance backs as recommended by District Treasurer David Miller.
- Payment of invoices, fiscal year 2010 appropriation modifications and fiscal year 2011 temporary appropriations as presented by David Miller.
