

Leipsic Board of Education Highlights

Special Meeting on Saturday, May 23, 2009 at 8:00 a.m. in the Administration Conference Room

In a special meeting on Sat., May 23, the Leipsic Board of Education approved contracts for the base bids and all alternate bids for the 1963 building renovation. This Board action is contingent on the post-bid review confirmation of the apparent bidders. Tentatively, bids were accepted from Mel Lanzer Co., general contractor; JB and Company, Inc., roofing; Fizenrider, Inc., HVAC; and Stollsteimer Electric, electrical. Total project cost is \$489,881.00.

The Board also voted to purchase Inlot Numbers 893; 394;895;896; 897, except the Southwest corner; 898 and 899 plus one half vacated alley from Larry P. Place and Carlotta H. Place. Final expense will include the purchase price and any other associated costs as agreed. The property will be the site for the geothermal well field, which will support the geothermal heating/cooling system in the CFAP building.

The Board approved a Memorandum of Understanding regarding Extended Programming for Mrs. Yvette Schroeder.

In light of the possible elimination of two calamity days by the state of Ohio in the 2009-2010 school year and plans to begin the CFAP portion of the building next spring, the Board of Education authorized the superintendent to amend the 2009-2010 school calendar. Members of the Leipsic Education Association were given the opportunity to vote on the changes prior to the Board of Education meeting.

Discussion items included a possible Memorandum of Understanding with the LEA for a three-hour delay schedule next school year that will take effect on the first day of the new school year.
