

***Leipsic Board of Education Meeting Highlights
Regular Meeting on Tuesday, September 14, 2010
High School Library***

The monthly Leipsic Board of Education meeting was held on Tuesday, September 14 in the high school library. All members were in attendance.

The prior meeting minutes and the financial statements were approved as presented. Treasurer David Miller, Elementary Principal Darren Henry, and High School Principal Mike Bute all submitted written summary reports of activities for Board members.

Under new business the Board approved advances for Federal programs and disposal of inventory as presented.

She indicated that the building project continues to be on-schedule at this time.
