CUSTOMER SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Scholarship Award consists of a single gift of \$1,000 that is paid directly to the student's selected institution of higher learning. The Company will award no more than twelve Scholarship Awards in any one year and no more than four awards may be received by students at any one high school.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION

- ❖ Minimum GPA of 3.00 (cumulative)
- ❖ Eligible for 2- and 4-year students
- ❖ Answers to essay questions must be comprehensive and complete
- ❖ Live within Benton Ridge, New Bavaria or North Creek exchanges
- ❖ Receive services from Benton Ridge Telephone Company or WATCH COMMUNICATIONS
- ❖ Must be accepted by a 2-year or 4-year college to apply, and
- ❖ Application must be received by March 5, 2018.

GUIDELINES FOR THE AWARD

1. The award is for a single school term and is not renewable.
2. The recipient must be accepted as a student at an institution of higher learning and the award will be paid directly to that institution.
3. **The award is available only to students who reside in one of our three telephone exchanges of Benton Ridge, New Bavaria, or North Creek, and who receive services from Benton Ridge Telephone Company or our subsidiary, WATCH COMMUNICATIONS.**
4. Benton Ridge Telephone Company, 1805 N Dixie Hwy, Lima, Ohio 45801, must receive applications for the award **no later than March 5, 2018.**
5. Each application must be accompanied by two written recommendations.
6. Each application must be accompanied by a copy of the applicant's high school transcript, senior first semester grades, standardized test scores, class ranking, and high school grade point average. (See section to be completed by guidance counselor.)
7. A committee of three directors of the Company will review all applications and will establish the finalists based upon the contents of the attached forms and on the submitted recommendations. Finalists may be personally interviewed prior to selection of the award recipients.
8. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.00.
