

Marvin Charles Ellerbrock Veterans Foundation Scholarship

These scholarships have been established to assist relatives of veterans in Putnam County. The Marvin Charles Ellerbrock Veterans Foundation (MCEVF) was created to improve the quality of life for veterans and their families in the northwest region of the State of Ohio. Marvin was a resident of Putnam County who lost his life on May 6, 1967 while serving his country in the Vietnam War.

In 2020 – Three \$1,000.00 non-renewable scholarships will be awarded.

Qualifications:

- Must be a 2020 graduating senior from one of the nine Putnam County high schools.
- Must be the son, daughter, brother, sister, grandson or granddaughter of a veteran (active duty or honorable discharge) who served in one of the following United States Armed Services Branches: Army, Air Force, Navy, Marines, National Guard or Coast Guard.
- Must be accepted as a full time student in an accredited college, university, or technical school.

Timeline:

- Application and essay about “what it means to you to be a relative of a veteran” must be received by April 17, 2020.
