Leipsic Education Memorial Dependent Scholarship

Deadline: April 18th

A fund has been established by the Leipsic Schools staff whereby one- \$250 scholarships may be awarded to dependent children of current LEA members. In order to be eligible, the student must meet the following criteria:

- Be a dependent child* of a Leipsic Education Association member who is an active paid member of the LEA and the scholarship fund at the time of the application deadline.
- Be a high school senior.
- Attend a college or university in the fall.
- Complete the application.
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Include an official school transcript.
- Cite evidence of community and school service. Include an activity summary sheet.
- Write an essay about your professional goals. It must be typed, major emphasis is placed on the quality of the essay. (See attached rubric for scoring.)
- Submit two letters of recommendation. The letters must be submitted in sealed envelopes with the signatures across the seal.
- Submit the application, transcript, activity summary sheet, essay, and letters of recommendation to the LEA President by 3 PM on April 18th.

Candidates who complete this application process will have their names entered into a lottery drawing at the LEA May meeting.

If there are more than two applicants who apply for the scholarship, the applications of the candidates who are not selected will be kept for the drawing the following year. Applications will be kept up to a maximum of four years.

Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college on behalf of the recipient.

^{*}Dependent children are defined as children who qualify as federal tax exemptions to the member.
