The Leipsic Board of Education is pleased to announce the availability of **up to ten** scholarships of **\$500 each** to help the Leipsic High School students further their education. These scholarships are funded thanks to the Leipsic Eagles Aerie 2793. A **total of \$5,000** will be awarded.

Preference will be given to applicants that are **not** a recipient of a full tuition scholarship or another local scholarship affiliated with the school of \$1,000 or more (Pro-Tec Scholarship, Knueven Scholarship, Ward Academic Scholarship or Harvey Eagle Scholarship).

The requirements are:

- Be a graduating senior of LHS.
- Have a GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Attend a post-secondary school toward a certificate, licensure, 3-year or 4-year degree program.
- Complete an application.
- Provide a short paragraph regarding applicant's goals and future plans (150 words minimum).
- Complete activity list or attach a resume.

The decision of the judges is final. These scholarships will be awarded at the Senior Awards assembly. The recipients of this award will need to bring a copy of their college invoice to the Leipsic Schools Treasurer for payment of this scholarship.
