The Putnam County Cattlemen's Association is offering a onetime scholarship to be awarded to qualified applicants based on this application form (dollar amount to be decided at selection time). Finalists for the scholarship *maybe contacted for a personal interview before the committee.*

Applicants shall be deemed more qualified if they have displayed leadership qualities in youth organizations, community activities, and agriculture related activities, although this is not mandatory. Applicants must have declared a major in some aspect of Agriculture.

The recipient must be a full-time student and maintain a minimum of a 2.0 accumulative grade point average. All applicants must attach a signed high school transcript.

The Selection Committee will consist of the Putnam County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship Committee. The winner will be announced at the 2017 Cattlemen's Association Banquet on Wednesday, January 25, at the Kalida K of C Hall.

Recipients will be selected from applications received and meeting the following qualifications:

1. Applicants should have an agricultural background and have a realistic business plan to enter the Ag industry.
2. A high school senior residing in Putnam County and have been accepted to an accredited two or four-year College or University (attach a copy of acceptance).
